WAKING THE GIANT INITIATIVE

Waking the Giant is an ecumenical initiative implemented jointly by the Lutheran World Federation (LWF), the World Council of Churches (WCC) and ACT Alliance (ACT) under the leadership of LWF. It comprises activities at the global and National levels aiming at building the capacity of churches and ecumenical actors to effectively contribute to the 2030 UN Agenda for Sustainable Development.

In Tanzania, the national ACT Forum is the owner of the national Waking the Giant initiative and the Christian Council of Tanzania (CCT) is the host organization. The program is now seeking a competent, dynamic individual with programmatic/technical understanding of the 2030 UN Agenda for Sustainable Development to fill in the position.

Position Title: Waking the Giant National Coordinator Tanzania

Reports to: CCT - Director of Advocacy and Development Programs

Location: Dar es Salaam

Length of Contract: 1 - renewable

Specific responsibilities and duties:

- a) Takes the lead in organizing and planning of activities and budgets of the National Waking the Giant initiatives, in close coordination with the ACT Forum Steering Group and global Coordinator based in Geneva;
- b) Keeps up-to-date information on SDG-related resources and processes in the country and shares relevant information with participating institutions and the Geneva coordination of the initiative.
- c) Represents Waking the Giant in SDG-related events within the country and establishes, expands and maintains contacts with relevant UN, government and non-government actors in the country;
- d) Leads fund-raising efforts at the national level on behalf of ACT Forum.
- e) Establishes and maintains contact with national and local media and actively promotes media coverage of SDG related activities of participating institutions within the country;
- f) Participates in and contributes actively to global-level Waking the Giant activities.
- g) Engage with policy and advocacy issues in the country.
- h) Provides quarterly written narrative and financial reports, supports reviews and evaluation processes on the Waking the Giant implementation in the country.

Qualifications and Skills

- Excellent knowledge of the Tanzanian context, Government agencies, civil society including the ecumenical landscape and development processes within the country;
- High level of acceptance by churches and church-related actors of various confessions;
- Knowledge and experience in areas relevant to SDGs 3 (health), 4 (education), 5 (gender equality), 10 (reducing inequalities), and 16 (peace and justice);
- Very good inter-personal, networking, oral and written communication skills and proficiency in English.

- Very good facilitation skills; IT skills and familiarity with modern means of communication.

General Conditions

The applicant must be a devoted Christian from CCT member Churches and must have his/her application endorsed by the Bishop or Church Leader, enclosed with copies of certificates and an up to date CV; with names and addresses of two referees.

Qualifications

The holder of this position must have the following;

Holder of a BA Degree or above preferably in Development studies, Economics, Community Development, Rural Development, Business Administration, Human Resource Management or Education from a recognized University/Institution; with three years experience minimum in a similar position. Must have a minimum age of 30 years.
