JOB ADVERTISEMENT FOR NUTRITIONISTS – LISHE ENDELEVU PROGRAM

The Christian Council of Tanzania, a highly reputable Faith Based Organization in the Country, seeks to recruit Tanzanian Nutritionists for 'Lishe Endelevu' a new program focusing at improving nutritional status of women of reproductive age and children under five in four districts of Dodoma region by addressing the underlying causes of malnutrition. The program will be implemented in four District Councils covering all wards in each District: Kondoa District Council, Kondoa Town Council, Dodoma City Council and Bahi District Council.

Duties and Responsibilities:

The Nutritionist is expected to:

- Implement 'Lishe Endelevu' Program strategies in one of the Districts for nutritional improvement of the pregnant and lactating women, women of reproductive age, and children under five years.
- Advising and presenting a balanced nutritional strategy
- Plan, organize, coordinate, and evaluate nutritional component of 'Lishe Endelevu' Program
- Develop and implement plan of care based on assessment of nutritional needs and available sources and correlates plan with other health care.
- Provide follow up continuity of care.
- Instruct individuals, families and community groups in nutritional principles, diet, food selection, and economics and adapts teaching plans to family/individual life style.
- Conduct and participate in community sensitization and education on nutritional related issues.
- Evaluates food service system and make recommendations on optional nutrition and quality food

Required Skills and Experience

- Have demonstrated experience in implementing community based nutrition specific and nutrition sensitive programs and activities with impact in the nutritional status of women of reproductive age and children.
- Previous or current experience of implementing nutrition and behavior change programs.
- Holder of undergraduate or post graduate degree in human nutrition
- At least 2 years experience
- Strong communication and community mobilization skills
- Capacity to establish networks
- Proficiency in the use of computer, office software packages
- Commitment to upholding the CCT values and principles.
- Preference will be given to eligible and qualified candidates.
